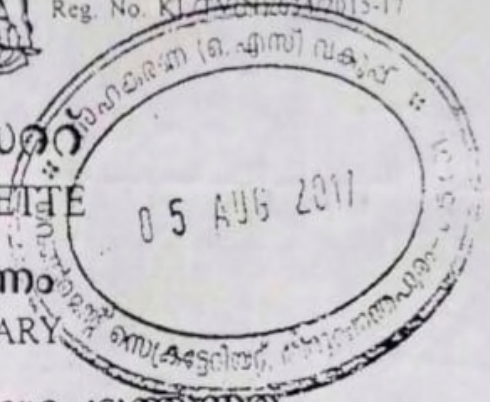

S. R. O. No. 484/2017.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 109 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969 (21 of 1969), the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules further to amend the Kerala Co-operative Societies Rules, 1969, the same having been previously published under Notification No. 12351/B1/2014/Co-op. dated 9th November, 2016 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 2035 dated 22nd November, 2016, as required by sub-section (1) of section 109 of the said Act, namely:—

RULES

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) These rules may be called the Kerala Co-operative Societies (2nd Amendment) Rules, 2017.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of the Rules.*—In the Kerala Co-operative Societies Rules, 1969, in rule 183, after the fourth proviso to sub-rule (1) the following proviso shall be added, namely:—

“Provided also that in the case of applicants who are widows, the upper age limit shall be raised by 5 years”.

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

As per sub-rule (1) of rule 183 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Rules, 1969, a candidate for appointment by direct recruitment must have completed eighteen years and must not have completed forty years of age on the first day of January of the year in which the applications for appointment are invited. The said rule has also provided for exemption from upper age limit to certain classes of applicants and there is no provision for relaxations in upper age limit to widows. Hence Government have decided to raise the upper age limit by five years for applicants who are widows and amend the said rules suitably.

This notification is intended to achieve the above object.
