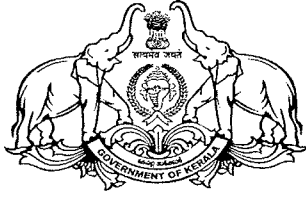

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 109 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969 (Act 21 of 1969), the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules, further to amend the Kerala Co-operative Societies Rules, 1969, the same having been previously published under Notification No. Co-Op-B1/209/2021/Co-op dated 3rd August, 2021 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No.2316 dated 4th August, 2021, as required by sub-section(1) of section 109 of the said Act namely:-



RULES

1. *Short title and commencement.*- (1) These rules may be called the Kerala Co-operative Societies (Amendment) Rules, 2021.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of the Rules* .- In the Kerala Co-operative Societies Rules, 1969, second proviso to sub-rule (5) of Rule 185, shall be omitted.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

Second proviso of sub-rule (5) of rule 185 of the Kerala Co-Operative Societies Rules, 1969 provides that $\frac{1}{2}$ mark for each completed year of service, subject to a maximum of ten marks shall be added on to the marks secured by each candidate in the qualifying examination as grace mark. The Registrar of Co-Operative Societies submitted proposal for amending the Rules to delete the above provision as recommended by the Examination Board. Accordingly, draft rules were previously published as required under sub-section (1) of section 109 of the Kerala Co-Operative Societies Act, 1969 (Act 21 of 1969) as per Notification No. Co-op-B1/209/2021-Co-op, dated 3rd August, 2021 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No.2316 dated 4th August, 2021 inviting suggestions or objections, if any, in respect of the said draft rules. The Government have considered the matter in detail and in order to get efficient candidates, decided to omit the proviso as recommended by the Examination Board.

This notification is intended to achieve the above object.
